New semester has started !

Just as we had announced in our last press release from January, our 2nd year CADIs have once again left for the Erasmus + exchange semester and the internship abroad or in France.

Some students have chosen our Spanish partner, the University of Nebrija in Madrid, as their Erasmus mobility destination, while others have decided to attend the University of Dundalk in Ireland.

The rest have taken the other solution and went abroad as a part of the Erasmus internship program. Mathieu is doing an internship with *Leyton Iberias*, an international company located in Madrid, Spain, Lorenzo has once again returned to Italy where he has taken the project management internship position in the company *Alu.spa* located in Romano d'Ezzelino. As for Lucas, he is doing his internship at *ABB*, a Swiss company located in Zurich.

When it comes to the rest of our students, they are doing their internship here in France. They are all situated in companies with rich international settings. Thus, this will provide them with a valuable opportunity to develop and improve their professional skills by working in a multicultural environment.

It does not take long for our students to readjust to an international life as it is evidenced from our correspondence with a student starting his Erasmus + exchange at our Spanish partner university from Madrid:

"Hello, I am bringing you news of our safe arrival to Madrid. The first few courses we attended went well, however, we had to change 1 course. The university here is quite large and very well equipped. We even have 2 French teachers! Life in Madrid is going really well for the moment. The weather is bit cloudy, but it does not stop us from trying to explore the entire city. We met with Mathieu who is starting his internship today. On a less serious note, the tapas and beer here are very good and so inexpensive! We have met and befriended many Erasmus students from different countries. "

The last step will be to validate their study or internship semester. Our final aim is for our students to obtain their RNCP BAC + 4 *Chargé (e) d'Affaires & de Développement à l'International*.

Our students have returned from their Erasmus + semester.

They all describe it as a very enriching experience during which they were able to learn how to adapt to different educational systems and adjust to new multicultural environments. It was interesting to notice how they all returned with an air of newly found maturity and responsibility. Moreover, we validated all their ECTS credits and were happy to observe their considerably improved level of English.

Additionally, we were pleased to welcome 3 new students for the summer semester. Two of them are studying the shipbuilding at the Technical University of Rijeka (Croatia), while one studied at the DKIT Dundalk (Ireland) and is continuing his 2nd semester here with us.

After our welcoming gathering, we had a lunch together after which we played a little friendly game of badminton, proudly wearing our multicultural colours!
